U.S. Healthcare Usage In 2019

- 1% of the population used 21% of all healthcare services.
- 5% of the population used 49% of all healthcare services.
- 20% of the population used 81% of all healthcare services.

- The average individual in America paid \$780 per month & the average family pays \$2,000 per month for traditional marketplace Health Insurance in 2022
- The #1 reason for bankruptcies is due to medical issues and bills
- Fifty-seven percent of American adults have been surprised by a medical bill that they thought would have been covered by insurance, according to the University of Chicago NORC Survey.
